#### Flu Season

From the Georgia Department of Public Health, "It is currently influenza (flu) season and Georgia and the United States are experiencing very high flu activity. We encourage students, parents, and staff to get a yearly flu vaccine and take everyday preventative actions to stop the spread of germs (cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze, wash your hands often with soap and water, avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth, and avoid close contact with sick people. Regularly clean and disinfect surfaces and objects that are touched often.

Students and staff should always stay home if they are ill. Those who get flu-like symptoms should stay home until at least 24 hours after they no longer have a fever or signs of a fever without the use of fever-reducing medicine. Symptoms of the flu can include fever (although not everyone with flu has fever), cough, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, body aches, headache, chills, tiredness, and sometimes diarrhea and vomiting."
