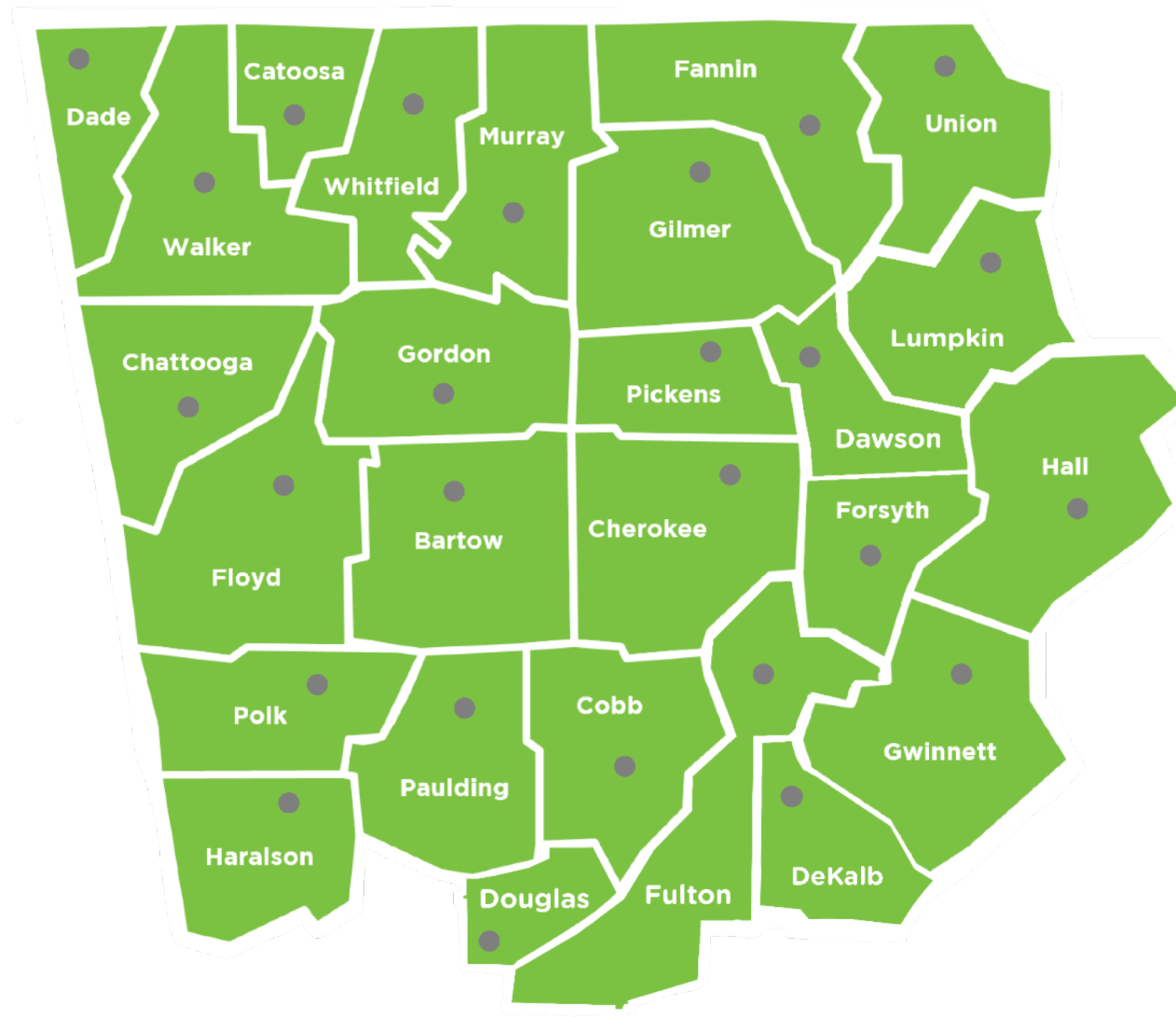

- Georgia HOPE provides **CORE services** in **26 counties** in NW Georgia
- **Social Services** are available **state-wide**
- **SBMH services** are offered in **6 counties**: Walker, Catoosa, Murray, Gordon, Floyd & Bartow



What are “Core Services?”

- Core Services are a continuum of services that are tailored to meet the needs of each individual.
- These services can be provided individually or in combination with each other.
- Services are driven by the client’s wants, needs, and preferences.

What are “Social Services?”

- Georgia HOPE is also a contracted provider of Social Services for the Department of Family and Children Services (DFCS)
- Services are similar in nature to Core Services but are paid for by DFCS rather than insurance

What is “School-Based Mental Health?”

- Georgia HOPE partners with school systems to **place therapists at select school sites** along with offering CSI services
- Builds **strong collaboration** amongst school personnel and Georgia HOPE staff to identify students at-risk with mental health needs
- **Universal Prevention Interventions** provided to all students at site regardless of tier assignment to promote positive social, emotional, and behavioral skills
